#### **Access**

The race center is located at the <u>Anthisnes football field, Rue Elva 11, 4160 Anthisnes</u> — marked in orange on the map.

The blue area is reserved for the organization.


Camper vans and those wishing to camp the night before the race may park in the purple zone. Arrival is only allowed between 5:00 PM and 9:00 PM on Saturday. Please avoid making noise after 10:00 PM.

Note: there will be no water, electricity or toilet facilities available in the camping zone. All waste must be taken with you — please do not use public bins for your trash.

The yellow zones represent the 4 other parking areas:

1. Rue Elva: HERE

Cour d'Omalius : <u>HERE</u>
 Rue du Moulin : <u>HERE</u>
 Place Legros : <u>HERE</u>



### **Belgian Enduro Cup**

The rules of the Belgian Enduro Cup apply to this event. You can read them <a href="here">here</a>.

- The Muscular & Ebike OPEN course is 33 km with 980 m of elevation gain and includes 8 stages.
- The Ebike BEC course is 38 km with 1180 m of elevation gain and includes 10 stages. Riders will repeat stages 6 & 7 after finishing stage 7.

### **Young Promotion Enduro Cup**

The rules of the Young Promotion Enduro Cup also apply. You can read them <a href="here">here</a>. Children will start in groups and will be supervised by adults. There will be no signage set up for them, so it is essential that they stay with their group and supervisors at all times. They must not follow the markings of the Belgian Enduro Cup or Trail Center.

Children will have access to a small refreshment station at the bottom of each stage.

#### Other Information

- Registration / race plate pickup: 07:15 08:30
  Please come early it's better for everyone.
- Opening/closing times of all stages are available <u>here</u>.
- Your timing chip is on the back of your number plate you are responsible for it in case of loss.
  - Plates must be mounted vertically.
- Riders will start in number order for protection checks, then free start every 15 seconds. Please remain courteous and keep the flow moving.
- There will be no cups at the feed zones, so bring your own bottle, CamelBak, or other.
- There will be a mandatory check at the hall for protective gear and number plates, in start list order. We start with YPEC at 8.00 and BEC at 8.15 starting with E-Bike. Start list is available HERE
- For stage details, points of interest, and parking near stages, see the maps <u>here</u>.
- For the BEC: please do not walk up stages 2 & 4, and stay at the bottom only. These are private properties and we have permission for rider access on race day only. Please follow this rule to ensure we can continue holding this event in the future.
